SIERRA ROADWORK SCHEDULE
Sunday through Saturday
November 27 – December 3, 2011

Most traffic interfering work will be limited from Wednesday, November 23 through Sunday, November 27 for the Thanksgiving Holiday.

LONG-TERM PROJECTS

Interstate 80 Donner Rest Areas (Nevada County) Work continues to replace both rest areas. When this \$3.4 million project is complete, the facilities and parking will be upgraded to meet the demands of the more than three million annual visitors and will be compliant with the Americans with Disabilities Act standards. The westbound facility is expected to be completed on November 22. The eastbound is expected to be completed on December 6.

State Highway 49 (Nevada County) Work has begun on the \$29 million Highway 49/La Barr Meadows Project that will widen State Route 49 to four lanes between Little Valley Road and Norambagua Way, just south of Grass Valley. The project includes a signalized intersection at La Barr Meadows Road, widening of shoulders, right- turn pockets and new sound walls. Completion is expected by fall 2012. **No traffic interfering work is scheduled.**

Interstate 80 (Placer and Nevada Counties) from Carpenter Flat to Hampshire Rock: Work continues on the \$167 million Emigrant Gap project on Interstate 80. Work includes total roadway replacement with Portland Cement Concrete, improving the





drainage systems and installing new sediment/debris collection systems. Completion is expected in the fall of 2013. **No traffic interfering work is scheduled.**

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from Donner Summit to Donner Lake: Work continues on the \$71 million Donner III Project to improve Interstate 80. Work includes repaving the existing roadway with Portland Cement Concrete, reconstructing failed sections of roadway, adding new drainage systems, upgrading existing drainage systems and construction of a new sediment/debris collection system. Completion is expected in early winter 2011. **THIS PROJECT IS NOW COMPLETE!**

SHORT-TERM PROJECTS

State Route 49 (El Dorado and Placer Counties) from State Route 193 to the Nevada County line: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls in various locations from **7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

State Route 49 (Yuba and Sierra Counties) from Marysville Road to the Yuba Pass Summit: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls in various locations from **7:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Friday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from State Route 89 south to Central Truckee: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane closures from **7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do bridge work.

State Route 174 (Placer County) from Main Street to Long Ravine Road: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **8 a.m. to 3 p.m. Monday through Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do underground utility work.

State Route 174 (Placer County) from Interstate 80 to the Nevada County line: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **7:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Monday through Friday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.
