## SIERRA ROADWORK SCHEDULE

### Sunday through Saturday

### January 22 – January 28, 2012

#### LONG-TERM PROJECTS

**Interstate 80 Donner Safety Roadside Rest Areas** (Nevada County) This \$12.5 million project is complete, the facilities have been upgraded to meet the demands of the more than three million annual visitors and is compliant with the Americans with Disabilities Act standards. The eastbound SRRA parking lot will be complete in spring of 2012.

**State Highway 49** (Nevada County) Work has begun on the \$29 million Highway 49/La Barr Meadows Project that will widen State Route 49 to four lanes between Little Valley Road and Norambagua Way, just south of Grass Valley. The project includes a signalized intersection at La Barr Meadows Road, widening of shoulders, right- turn pockets and new sound walls. Completion is expected by fall 2012. **Project is in winter suspension.**

**Interstate 80** (Placer and Nevada Counties) from Carpenter Flat to Hampshire Rock: Work continues on the \$167 million Emigrant Gap project on Interstate 80. Work includes total roadway replacement with Portland Cement Concrete, improving the drainage systems and installing new sediment/debris collection systems. Completion is expected in the fall of 2013. **Project is in winter suspension.**

#### SHORT-TERM PROJECTS

**State Route 20** (Nevada County) from the Yuba County line to Interstate 80: Motorists can expect east and westbound lane closures from **8:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Friday.** A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.





**State Route 49** (Nevada County) from the Placer County line to the Yuba County line: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls in various locations from **9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Friday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

**State Route 49** (El Dorado and Placer Counties) from State Route 193 to the Nevada County line: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls in various locations from **8 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Monday through Friday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

**State Route 49** (Yuba and Sierra Counties) from Marysville Road to Yuba Pass Summit: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls in various locations from **7:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Friday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

**State Route 49** (Placer County) from El Dorado Street to the East Auburn Underpass: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls in various locations from **5 a.m. to noon Sunday**. A contractor is scheduled to do utility work.

**Interstate 80** (Placer County) from State Route 193 to Gold Run: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane closures from **8 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Monday through Friday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

**State Route 174** (Nevada County) from Interstate 80 to Auburn Street in Grass Valley: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Tuesday through Friday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled for miscellaneous maintenance work.

**State Route 193** (Placer County) from County Road P57 to Rainbow Valley Lane: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control from **9 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. Friday**. A Caltrans maintenance crew is scheduled to do survey work.
