Sierra Roadwork Schedule

Sunday through Saturday

May 1 – May 7, 2011

LONG-TERM PROJECTS

On Interstate 80, the east and westbound Donner Rest Areas will be closed through **November 1**. A contractor is scheduled to replace both rest areas. When this \$3.4 million project is complete, the facilities and parking will be upgraded to meet the demands of the more than three million annual visitors and will be compliant with the Americans with Disabilities Act standards.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Carpenter Flat to Hampshire Rock: Work continues on the \$167 million Emigrant Gap project on Interstate 80. Work includes total roadway replacement, improving the drainage systems and installing new sediment/debris collection systems. **No traffic interfering work is scheduled.**

Interstate 80(Nevada County) from Donner Summit to Donner Lake: Work continues on the \$71 million Donner III construction project to improve Interstate 80. Work includes repaving the existing roadway, reconstructing failed sections of roadway, adding new drainage systems, upgrading existing drainage systems and construction of a new sediment/debris collection system. Completion is expected in 2011. **Project is in winter suspension.**

Interstate 80 (Nevada/Sierra Counties) Eastbound from Truckee River Bridge to State Line: Work has begun on a \$1.7 million concrete barrier project, along Interstate 80, east of Truckee. The project will replace existing guardrail with permanent concrete barrier at seven locations. Work on the project will be completed by June 30, 2011.

May 1 – May 7

Interstate 80 (Nevada/Sierra Counties) from Truckee River Bridge to Nevada State Line: Motorists can expect eastbound lane closures and minimal delays from **5:00 a.m. Monday through 1:00 p.m. Thursday**. A contractor is installing concrete barrier at various locations.

SHORT-TERM PROJECTS

State Route 20 (Nevada County) from Gold Flat Road to Broad Street: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane and ramp closures from **9:00 a.m. to 5:00 a.m. Sunday through Saturday**. A contractor is scheduled to remove and replace median safety equipment.

State Route 49 (Nevada County) from Placer County Line to Yuba County Line: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control from **7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled for miscellaneous maintenance work.

State Route 49 (Placer County) from Kemper/New Airport Road to Atwood Road: Motorists can expect intermittent northbound lane closures from **8:30 a.m. to 5:00 a.m. Monday through Thursday**. A contractor is scheduled for permit work.

State Route 49 (Nevada County) from Crestview Drive to McKnight Way: Motorists can expect intermittent northbound lane closures from **8:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m. Sunday**

through Friday. A contractor is scheduled to remove and replace safety equipment in the median.

State Route 49 (Yuba/Sierra Counties) from Marysville Road to Yuba Pass: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control from **6:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Wednesday.** A Caltrans crew is scheduled for miscellaneous maintenance work.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from Placer County Line to Donner Lake: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane closures from **7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday.** A Caltrans crew is scheduled for guardrail repair.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from Observation (Vista Point) to Castle Peak: Motorists can expect various eastbound lane closures from **6:00 a.m. (10:00 a.m. Friday) to 6:00 p.m. Monday through Friday.** A contractor is scheduled to do striping work.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from Observation Point to Donner Park: Motorists can expect various eastbound lane closures from **6:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. (11:00 a.m. Thursday) (9:00 a.m. Friday) Monday through Friday.** A contractor is scheduled to do drainage work.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from Castle Peak to Donner Park: Motorists can expect various westbound lane closures from **6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. (10:00 a.m. Friday) Monday through Friday.** A contractor is scheduled for striping work.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from State Route 267/89 Separator to Donner Lake: Motorists can expect intermittent westbound lane closures from **5:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. (9 a.m. Monday) (10 a.m. Friday) Monday through Friday.** A contractor is scheduled for drainage work.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from Sierra County Line to Donner Lake: Motorists can expect intermittent east and westbound lane closures from **7:15 a.m. to 4:45 p.m.**

Monday through Thursday. A Caltrans maintenance crew is scheduled for miscellaneous work.

Interstate 80 (Placer/Nevada Counties) from Yuba Gap to Cisco Grove: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane closures from **6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Monday through Thursday.** A contractor is scheduled for survey and striping/markings work.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Magra Road to Nevada County Line: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane closures from **8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday.** A Caltrans crew is scheduled for miscellaneous work.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from State Route 193/Hillview to Gold Run: Motorists can expect intermittent westbound lane closures from **7:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday.** A Caltrans crew is scheduled for miscellaneous maintenance work.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Yuba Gap to Nevada County Line: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane closures from **7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday.** A Caltrans crew is scheduled for guardrail repair.

Interstate 80 (Placer/Nevada Counties) from Cisco Grove to Separate Align: Motorists can expect intermittent westbound lane closures from **6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Monday through Thursday.** A contractor is scheduled for striping/markings work.

Interstate 80 (Sierra County) from Nevada County Line to Nevada State Line: Motorists can expect intermittent westbound lane closures from **7:15 a.m. to 4:45 p.m. Monday through Thursday.** A Caltrans crew is scheduled for miscellaneous work.

State Route 89 (Nevada County) from Hobart Mills Road to Prosser Dam Road/Alder Drive: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control from **7:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Wednesday.** A Caltrans crew will be trimming trees and brush.

State Route 89 (Placer County) from Truckee River Bridge to Nevada County Line: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control from **7:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Wednesday**. A Caltrans crew will be trimming trees and brush.

State Route 174 (Placer County) from Main Street to Bear River Bridge: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control from **7:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled for miscellaneous maintenance work.

The Caltrans District Traffic Management Branch has reviewed each project and determined that individual project delays are expected to be less than the statewide policy maximum of 30 minutes, unless noted otherwise above.

Lanes are numbered from the center divide (#1) to the shoulder (#2, 3, 4, etc.). Unexpected schedule changes may occur.
