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Sierra Roadwork Schedule

Sunday through Saturday

August 28 – September 3, 2011

Due to Labor Day holiday, traffic-interfering work will be limited from Friday, September 2 through Tuesday, September 6

LONG-TERM PROJECTS

Interstate 80 Donner Rest Areas (Nevada County) Work continues to replace both rest areas. When this \$3.4 million project is complete, the facilities and parking will be upgraded to meet the demands of the more than three million annual visitors and will be compliant with the Americans with Disabilities Act standards. Work is expected to be completed on the westbound rest area by mid-summer 2011. Expected completion for the eastbound rest area is late fall 2011.

State Highway 49 (Nevada County) Work has begun on the \$29 million Highway 49/La Barr Meadows Project that will widen State Route 49 to four lanes between Little Valley Road and Norambagua Way, just south of Grass Valley. The project includes a signalized intersection at La Barr Meadows Road, widening of shoulders, right- turn pockets and new sound walls. Completion is expected by fall 2012. **No traffic interfering work is scheduled.**

Interstate 80 (Placer and Nevada Counties) from Carpenter Flat to Hampshire Rock: Work continues on the \$167 million Emigrant Gap project on Interstate 80. Work includes total roadway replacement with Portland Cement Concrete, improving the drainage systems and installing new sediment/debris collection systems.

August 28 – September 1

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from Emigrant Gap to Cisco Grove: Motorists can expect a single, narrow eastbound lane and delays of up to 20 minutes from **7:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m. Monday through Thursday**. A contractor is scheduled for paving work.

August 29 – September 1

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) at the Yuba Gap, State Route 20, Eagle Lake Road, Emigrant Gap, Cisco Grove and Rainbow interchanges: Motorists can expect westbound on and off-ramp closures from **5 a.m. to 6 p.m. (12 noon on Thursday) Monday through Thursday. Consecutive ramps will not be closed**. A contractor is scheduled for paving.

State Route 20 (Nevada County) at the Interstate 80 Junction: Motorists can expect the east and westbound intermittent lane and ramp closures from **5 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday through Thursday. Motorists can expect up to 15 minute delays**. A contractor is scheduled for bridge work.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from Donner Summit to Donner Lake: Work continues on the \$71 million Donner III Project to improve Interstate 80. Work includes repaving the existing roadway with Portland Cement Concrete, reconstructing failed sections of roadway, adding new drainage systems, upgrading existing drainage systems and construction of a new sediment/debris collection system. Completion is expected in fall 2011.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) at the Castle Peak and Donner Lake interchanges. Motorist can expect the eastbound on-ramp at Castle Peak and the eastbound off-ramp to Donner Lake closed through **October 14** for reconstruction.

August 30 – 31

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from the Donner Summit to Donner Park: motorist can expect various eastbound lane closures from **6 a.m. to 6 p.m. Tuesday and Wednesday**. A contractor is scheduled for miscellaneous construction work.

SHORT-TERM PROJECTS

State Route 20 (Nevada County) from the Yuba County Line to the I-80 junction: Motorists can expect north and southbound lane closures from **7 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A Caltrans maintenance crew is scheduled for miscellaneous work.

State Route 20 (Nevada County) at the Brighton Street overcrossing in Grass Valley: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control form **6 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A contractor is scheduled for bridge repair.

State Route 49 (Nevada and El Dorado Counties) from the Bear River Bridge to Cool: Motorists can expect traffic controls at various locations from **7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled for miscellaneous maintenance work.

State Route 49 (Nevada County) from the Bear River Bridge to Yuba County Line: Motorists can expect various north and southbound lane closures from **6:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled for miscellaneous maintenance work.

State Routes 20 and 49 (Nevada County) at the 20/49 junction: Motorists can expect various north and southbound lane closures from **8 p.m. to 6 a.m. Monday through Thursday**. A contractor is scheduled to remove k-rail.

State Route 49 (Nevada County) at the South Fork Yuba River Bridge: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control from **6 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A contractor is scheduled for bridge repair.

State Route 49 (Sierra County) at Ladies Canyon: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control from **6 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A contractor is scheduled for bridge repairs.

State Route 49 (Yuba and Sierra Counties) from Marysville Road to the Yuba Pass: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control from **6:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled for miscellaneous maintenance work.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Castle Peak to Donner Lake: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane closures from **7 a.m. to 1 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled for miscellaneous maintenance work.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from the California Agricultural Inspection Station to the Truckee River Bridge: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane and shoulder closures from **5 a.m. to 8 p.m. (9 a.m. on Thursday) Sunday through Thursday**. A contractor is scheduled for drainage work.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Newcastle to Gold Run: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane closures from **7 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled for miscellaneous maintenance work.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Ophir Road to Lincoln Way in Auburn: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane and ramp closures from **8 p.m. to 7 a.m. Sunday through Saturday**. A contractor is grinding and paving.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Clipper Gap to Weimar Cross Road: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane and ramp closures from **7 p.m. to 7 a.m. Monday through Thursday**. A contractor is scheduled for grinding and paving.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) at the State Route 89 North exit: Motorists can expect traffic controls and shoulder closures from **7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A contractor has begun work to construct a right-turn lane.

State Route 89 (Nevada County) from Interstate 80 to Rainbow Drive: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control from **6 a.m. to 9 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A contractor is scheduled for utility work.

State Route 89 (Nevada County) from Rainbow Drive to Alder Creek Road: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control from **7 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled for shoulder backing.

State Route 89 (Nevada County) at Prosser Creek: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **6 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A contractor is scheduled for bridge work.

State Route 89 (Sierra County) at the Little Truckee River: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **6 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A contractor is scheduled for bridge repairs.

State Route 89 (Sierra County) from Willow to Main Streets: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **6:45 a.m. to 4:45 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled for mowing.

State Route 174 (Nevada County) from the I-80 junction to the Bear River Bridge: Motorists can expect traffic controls at various locations from **7 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled for miscellaneous maintenance work.

State Route 267 (Nevada County) from Truckee to Northstar Drive: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control from **6 p.m. to 12 noon Monday through Thursday**. A contractor is scheduled for a crack sealing operation.

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The Caltrans District Traffic Management Branch has reviewed each project and determined that individual project delays are expected to be less than the statewide policy maximum of 30 minutes, unless noted otherwise above.

Lanes are numbered from the center divide (#1) to the shoulder (#2, 3, 4, etc.). Unexpected schedule changes may occur.
